ITAR impact on Amateur Satellites: Amateur as well as professional satellites fall under export control regulations (ITAR). This has caused real difficulties for Amsat-NA and the Amsat-DL Phase-3E project which was due to use an Amsat-NA modules. Recently Amsat-NA has made a voluntary declaration to the US Government to set the past record straight and avoid penalties, but it continues to hinder the support they can lend to others. It was agreed that these issues need to be carefully monitored / managed.
