



IARU Region 1 Award



The purpose of this award is to generate activity on the HF bands whilst recognising the work of the International Amateur Radio Union Region 1.

The award may be claimed by any licensed radio amateur who can produce evidence of having contacted amateur radio stations in the required number of countries whose national societies are members of the Region 1 Division of the International Amateur Radio Union (IARU)

There are 3 classes for contacts as follows:

- Class 1 All 97 member countries on the current list
- Class 2 60 member countries
- Class 3 40 member countries

Confirmation of two-way contacts is required either by QSL cards, LOTW or Clublog for contacts on 160, 80, 40, 30, 20, 17, 15, 12 and 10m.

To apply for the award, please list claimed contacts in the IARU Region 1 Award spreadsheet which have confirmed status on LOTW or Clublog, or for which you are submitting relevant QSL cards (sorted in prefix order), and sign the declaration below. Send this application form and the spreadsheet:
