There are 3 classes for contacts as follows:

- Century 100 Commonwealth call areas
- Silver 70 Commonwealth call areas
- Bronze 40 Commonwealth call areas

Awards are available on: 5 bands (80m, 40m, 20m, 15m & 10m) or 9 HF bands (160m to 10m).

To apply for the award, please list claimed contacts in the Commonwealth Century Award spreadsheet which have confirmed status on LoTW or for which you hold relevant QSL cards (which can be submitted by post or as scanned images) and sign the declaration below.
