RSGB Intermediate 100 Award

This award is available to holders of UK Intermediate Licences and is designed to encourage activity by making 100 contacts across four designated HF bands during their first year of being licensed.



Contacts may be made using CW, SSB or Data modes, as appropriate, on 80m, 40m, 30m and 17m with a maximum of 25 contacts per band. Multiple contacts with the same amateur do not count.

To apply for your certificate, please list claimed contacts in the attached table, have it verified and sign the Declaration. All claims must include a log extract certified by an RSGB affiliated club official or two licensed amateurs holding a Full licence.

There is no charge for this award.
