

Who and what...

ITU-R

- World Radio Conference sets the International Radio Regulations (RRs)
- High level frequency allocations for each Region
- Top Level Framework, Satellite filings etc

CEPT

- Regional Allocations, Harmonises usage
- Only generic licensing
- Specific uses, Licence-exempt Short Range Devices

Ofcom

- National Allocations, Specific Uses/Assignments
- Technical Interface Regulations
- Licence Conditions and Licensees


















World Radio Conference Process

ITU-R

- WRC-19: 28th October to 22nd November 2019, Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt
- Supported beforehand by ITU Study Groups preparing reports etc over the 2016-2019 period since WRC-15
- WRC-19 will also agree the agenda for WRC-23 and assigns ITU task groups for it immediately afterwards (in meeting CPM23-1 on Nov-25/6)

CEPT

- The Conference Preparatory Group (CPG) coordinates European Common Proposals (ECPs) and Briefs
- Supported by five CEPT Project Teams for specific agenda items
 - CEPT-PTA, PTB, PTC, PTD and PT1 and coordinators for each item
- Other Regional Telecomms Organisations (RTOs) have equivalent process

Ofcom

- National Preparations/Positions
- Considered via Ofcom IFPG International Frequency Planning Group
- Nominally four IFPG teams, plus a top level and AI-10 (future items) group
