The role involves:

- Management to promote the RSGB Strategy 2022
- Regular reporting to the Board via the designated Board Liaison Member (BLM)
- Leading the launch and management of the Beyond Exams initiatives and continually growing the suite

- Desire and enthusiasm to promote and develop the future and growth of the hobby
- Experience in project management would be a distinct advantage, but not essential
