

2022 RSGB Band Plans

In this edition of *RadCom* are the 2022 Band Plans. This year's update is very modest and is largely editorial in nature:

- **HF:** The countries in the 136kHz ITU Regulation footnote has been updated in line with WRC-19 – Iran is no longer included
- **VHF:** The growth in low power internet voice gateways has resulted in an updated designation for 144.8750 to 144.9125MHz (in 12.5kHz channels) – which was previously used by packet radio.

Editorial updates include a correction to the 50MHz Note 6 regarding experimental bandwidths.

Please note that the RSGB Band Plans are current and are thus quite distinct from the longer term discussion for the HF bands that is occurring at IARU level and was presented at the 2021 RSGB Spectrum Forum annual meeting.
