WRC-23: Summary



- ITU-R WRC-23 Conference set for 20th Nov 15th Dec 2023
- Venue: Dubai-WTC (not Geneva) due to ITU building work
- Several agenda items of concern in addition to 23cms
- AI-10 Future Agenda items for WRC-27/31 now emerging

WRC-23: Agenda Item 9.1b / 23cm

- IARU is engaged and representing the amateur services in all the international regulatory groups.
- RSGB Volunteers play a leading role
- Both CEPT & ITU have multiple groups making for a high workload (CEPT SE40, PTC, CPG and ITU WP4C & WP5A)
- IARU believes that the interference potential is over-stated.

 Overall studies and draft conclusions are heading into the WRC-23 CPM Report due in Spring 2023










WRC-23: Broader Concerns

- 50MHz: Al-1.12 will authorise wideband satellite borne climate change radars across 40-50MHz – a key concern
 - Waveform centred on 45MHz but spurious emissions and increased power and reduced mitigation is a concern for 50 MHz DX segment
- AI-9.1a / WRC-27 Protection of Space Weather sensors has very broad scope to impact usage across LF / HF / UHF+
- Also...
 - AI-1.14: 240GHz Climate change sensors
 - AI-10: 6G/IMT-2023 and several others...









WRC-23: Consultation

- Ofcom consulted on WRC23 including Future Agenda over June-September 2022
- Detailed RSGB Response provided and published
- RSGB remain engaged via IFPG and CEPT—PTA UK-Del

Currently awaiting formal statement but we expect UK views to change slightly -such as Future Agenda and 7GHz Wi-Fi vs IMT














IARU-R1 Interim 2022

- Held at Friedrichshafen rather than Vienna
- First physical/hybrid meeting, relatively low inputs
- RSGB Papers three in C4 for HF matters (Bandplan, Handbook, Contests)
- C4-HF modest progress on Bandplan review
- C5-VHF-Microwave interactive, but few decisions
- C7-EMC well attended but mainly a progress discussion

- C3 nothing formal
 - but a public update on Shaping the Future Phase-1 progress given









IARU-R1 General Conference 2023

- Scheduled for Serbia but no longer Novi Sad
- Venue now Zlatibor on Nov 1st 4th
- Length slightly shorter with focus on C3/StF
- Timetable:-
 - 31-Oct-2022: Call for papers
 - 1-Feb-2022: Delegation intent
 - 1-Aug-2023: Paper submission
 - 23-Aug-2023: Paper distribution
 - 1/4-Nov-2023: Conference
